Instruction

- Remove the cap, and press down on nozzle to dispense foam onto the soft silicone bristles.
- Gently massage foam onto paws in circular motions, making sure to get in-between the paw pads.
- Wipe dry. No rinsing necessary.
- Use after every walk, or as often as needed.
- To clean silicone bristles, remove brush cover & rinse under warm water.

Key Functional Ingredients

Gentle foaming agent system based on olivoil glutamate (Cosmos Ecocert approved), easy biodegradability.

The 'surf-active' concept refers to the capability of specific molecules of acting at the same time both as surfactant and skin/hair functional ingredient.

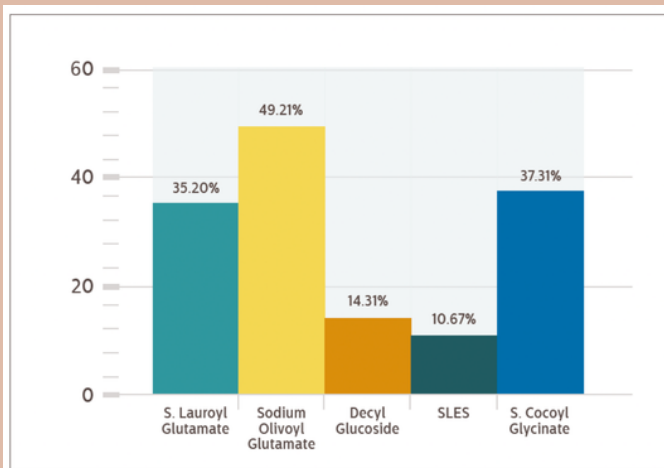


Figure 1: Hydration values average percentage variation

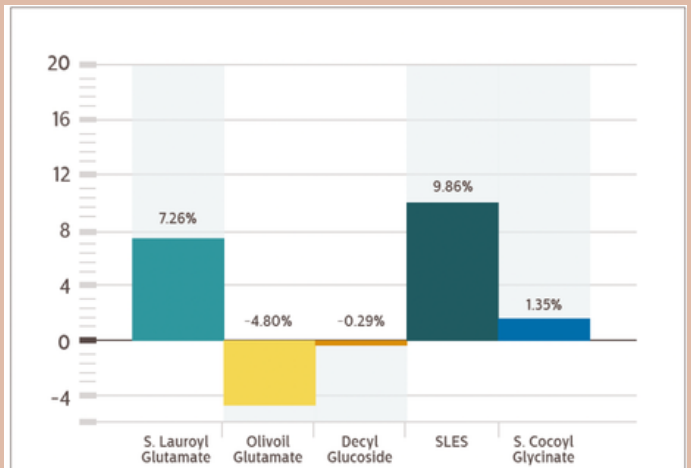


Figure 2: Erithema index values average percentage variation
